Boulder Medical Center will be accepting Medicare Assignment for dates of service of 1/1/2013 and beyond.

What does this mean to you our valued patient?

Boulder Medical Center will now be submitting a claim on your behalf and the Medicare contractor will reimburse BMC for services rendered. You will no longer be receiving the funds for services rendered by BMC providers. You will no longer be responsible for depositing the Medicare check to your personal bank account and then having to write a check to BMC.

In order to streamline these processes we will ask that all patients please stop at the front cashiers stand to not only update your personal information but to have any and all insurance cards scanned into our system for billing use.

All Personal information sheets will need to be updated and signed yearly for proper billing purposes.

BMC will also do courtesy billing of your secondary claims; however, if those courtesy claims are not processed or paid within 30 days we will be sending out a statement to you.

To streamline this process you may contact Medicare and ask about automatic crossover.

BMC will not be accepting any Medicare Advantage or Replacement plans; this is not a change. If you have questions on whether you have a supplemental or Advantage or Replacement plan we recommend you contact your insurance carrier.
